Charter College & Career Prep AN ALTERNATIVE PATH TO SUCCESS

Charter College & Career Prep (CCP) serves students who would benefit from an alternative setting. Students who are experiencing difficulty meeting behavioral, social, academic, and/or attendance standards, may need assistance in goal setting or other supports in order to meet their individual learning needs. We create individual learning plans focused on student objectives, which include academic counseling, credit recovery, acceleration, and post-secondary options. We are a seat-based program that has the flexibility to create customized plans based on student achievement.

CAREER OPPORTUNTIES

Students interested in high-demand career opportunities, may benefit from the CCP program, which provides the vocational, academic, and social skills necessary to successfully transition to a successful career or a post high school training opportunity. We integrate state *Career Technical Education* standards in order to prepare students for work and career goals.

Our career-based classes vary from year to year based on demand and opportunities. We are currently offering courses in the following: Career Exploration Wheel, Art, Strategies and Gaming, Culinary Arts (Serve Safe Certificate opportunity), Outdoor

Gardening, Global Studies, Student Government, and Criminal Justice. Inquire about our new courses when meeting with an administrator about enrollment opportunities.



ADVANCED EDUCATION PROGRAM

College & Career Prep provides an Advanced Education Program (AEP) offered in partnership with the Folsom Lake College satellite campus, adjacent to our school. Students can and are encouraged to take community college courses while still in high school. Students earn high school and college credit concurrently. This opportunity is tuition-free.

The Advanced Education Program is an excellent way to start on the path to career advancement. In addition, credits earned are transferrable to colleges and universities. Meta-majors at the college include but are not limited to Business and Management, Liberal Arts and Social Sciences, Public Service, Health and Education, Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.

Folsom Lake College and the staff at College & Career Prep work together to provide a support system for potential and participating students. The team includes an outreach Specialist from Folsom Lake College to assist with enrollment and financial aid applications.

REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM

College & Career Prep students have the opportunity to apply and participate in the local Regional Occupational Program (ROP) offered by surrounding schools. Our collaborative partnerships with our local college, surrounding high schools, and local businesses work together so that our students, and other students in the community, have the opportunity to be job ready upon graduation.

CHARTER ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS

College & Career Prep is part of Charter Alternative Programs (CAP) and managed by the El Dorado County Office of Education. CAP is comprised of several unique programs specifically designed to meet a variety of educational, emotional, and social needs, for students in Kindergarten through Adult Education. In addition, Charter Alternative Programs offers an Extended Day childcare program working in partnership with our local Districts. Our programs are fully accredited through the Schools Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
